

# Amigurumi Lamb Pattern



## Materials

Amigurumi make great stash busters! Use any left over yarn but make sure you use a smaller crochet hook than recommended.

Have fun with the features and use safety eyes, buttons or embroidery.

You will also need a tapestry needle for sewing, and some stuffing for the body and the head.

Use a pin or piece of yarn as a marker to mark rows.

I allowed 50 grams of white, gold, black, brown or rainbow, 8 ply DK yarn for MC, a small amount of 8ply/DK, for CC, and a size 3:00 mm, crochet hook.

The lambs stand 6cm tall from top of head to toes.

This pattern can easily be used to make larger lambs by using a larger hook and thicker yarn.

You can use a slicker brush to make your lamb more woolly, or eye lash yarn as I used for the golden lamb.



## Abbreviations

- MC. Main color.
- CC. Contrast color.
- Ch. Chain
- Sc. Single crochet
- BLO. Back Loops only.
- M.M Move marker.
- FO. Fasten off.
- Tog. Together.
- St. Stitch.
- Sk st. Skip stitch.
- Dec. Decrease. Crochet 2 sts tog.
- Inc. Increase. Crochet 2 sts into 1 st.

**Head.** Make 1. Move marker at end of each row.

- Ch 2. R.1. 6sc into 2<sup>nd</sup> st from hook. (6sc)
- R.2. 2 sc into each sc all around. (12sc)
- R3. 1 sc into next sc, 2 sc in next sc. X6. (18sc)
- R.4. 1 sc into next 2 sc, 2 sc into next sc. X6. (24 sc)
- R5. to R.8. 1 sc all around. (24 sc)

**If using safety eyes and/or nose place now.**

- R9. 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc together. X6 (18sc)

**Lightly stuff** with stuffing of choice.

- R10. 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc together. x 6. (12 sc)
- R11. sc 2 tog. x 6.
- R12. Cut yarn, leaving enough to thread through remaining 6 sts and fasten off.



## To make up.

- Sew ears to head,
- Sew head to body.
- Sew on legs.
- Attach tail.
- Complete features.
- Lamb can stand or sit.
- Enjoy your lamb!

## Legs. Make 4.

Using contrast or main color (depending if you want different color hoofs to body) Ch 2.

- R1, 6 sc into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook. (6sc)
- R2 . BLO, 1 sc into each sc. (6sc)
- Change to MC if using CC for hoofs
- R3 to 7, 1 sc in each sc. MM at end of each row. (6sc)
- Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing.



## Ears. make 2.

- Ch 7. (7 sc)
- R1. sk first ch, 1 ch in each ch to end, ch 1 and turn. (6ch)
- R2. 1 sc in each sc to end. 1 ch, turn. (6ch)
- R3. 1 sc in each sc to end. 1 ch, turn. (6ch)
- R4. 1 sc in each sc to end. turn. (6ch)
- R5. sk first sc, 1 sc in next 4sc, turn. (4sc)
- R6. sk first sc, 1sc in next 3 sc and fasten off. (3sc)

**Body.** Make 1 .Move marker at end of each row.

- Ch 2.
- R.1. 6sc into 2<sup>nd</sup> st from hook. (6sc)
- R.2. 2sc into each sc. (12sc)
- R3. 1 sc into next 3sc, 2 sc into next sc. x 3. (15sc)
- R4. 1 sc into next 4 sc, 2 sc into next sc. x 3. (18sc)
- R5. 1 sc into next 5 sc, 2 sc into next sc. x 3. (21sc)
- R6 to R9, 1 sc in each sc. (21sc)
- R10. 1 sc into next 5 sc, dec. x3. (18sc)
- R11. 1 sc into next 4 sc, dec. x3. **lightly stuff** (15 sc)
- R12.1 sc into next 3 sc, dec. x 3. (12sc)
- R13. dec x 3. Cut yarn leaving 8 cm tail, weave and FO.



## Tail. Make 1.

- Ch. 7
- 1 sc into each ch to end.
- Cut yarn leaving a 10 cm tail.
- Thread yarn back through tail and attach to body as the last step.
